



Why sell with us? Are you thinking about a yard sale, but don't want to deal with people tromping around your home, cars parked all over the street and lawns, and upset neighbors? Why not rent a space at Webbs Chapel UMC's Community Yard Sale to hold your sale in a central location with easy parking!?

If you would like to hold your own yard sale as part of a multi-family sale, this is your chance! Webbs Chapel UMC will be advertising this event to the community and expects a large number of shoppers.

How do I reserve a space? To reserve a space, complete the Seller's Agreement found at webbsumc.com and complete payment at paypal.me/WebbsUMCDenver.

Mail completed form and payment to *Webbs Chapel UMC, c/o Aimee Yeager, P.O. Box 116, Denver, NC 28037*. Checks should be made out to Webbs Chapel UMC with "Community Yard Sale" in the memo.

Payment for reserved booths must be received by the church no later than Monday, May 13th.

What will shoppers find at the sale? Sellers will be selling new and used items, such as household goods, clothes, baby items, toys, etc. Vendors may also sell handmade crafts and food items, such as jellies, cakes, pickles, etc. The church will be selling food and drinks for shoppers to enjoy while they browse and bake sale items to take home.

When is the sale? Saturday, May 18th from 7 a.m. until 12 p.m.

Where is the sale? The sale will be held at Webbs Chapel United Methodist Church in Denver. Vendors will be set up at the church all around our large gym and Family Life Center. Webbs Chapel UMC is located behind the Sailview neighborhood at the corner of Webbs Chapel Church & McConnell Roads.

Who can rent a space and what is the cost? All are welcome to rent a 10' x 10' space to sell household goods, crafts, and products for a \$20 rental fee per space. (*No sales of ready-to-eat food or drinks without prior approval.*) Each seller's space will be marked off and empty. Tables will be made available to seller for an additional fee. Those who reserve a table will have the choice of a 5'-round or an 8'-long table. Tables will be provided on a first-come-first-serve basis. (A centrally located "Testing Area", where potential purchasers can plug-in electronic items to test them before purchasing, will be made available at no fee.) Sellers may bring their own tables and chairs as needed free of charge.

Don't want to load up and take your stuff home with you at the end of the day? Sellers may register for charitable donation pick-up at no additional cost! A local charity will collect all donated items left after the sale ends with no extra hassle for you!

Where are the funds from the rental fee going? This event is a fundraiser for the Webbs Chapel UMC Youth Group. All funds raised will be used to cover expenses of discipleship, fellowship, and missions projects.

When can sellers set up? Seller setup will be Friday, May 17 from 5-8 p.m. and Saturday from 6-7 a.m.

What about weather? Fear not! The entire event will be indoors! So you do not need to worry about rain, cold, or heat. In case of an extremely inclement forecast, Webbs Chapel UMC reserves the right to reschedule the event by notifying you no later than Thursday, May 16, at the email address you provide on the Seller's Agreement. *There will be no refunds for any reason.*
